No surprise the people who get "elected" have so little experience with the voters that the least citizen discontent results in the police being called out, tasers in hand.





The Moon & the Overweight Problem, part 3

F the progressed Moon is increasing in light the native will want to eat more, so that any dietary lapse counteracts a transiting-decreasing Moon's reducing power.

If only somewhat overweight, start with the 1st quarter New Moon on a 3.5 day liquid diet (fruit and vegetable juices, coffee and tea taken plain, soups and skim milk), augmented during the next 3.5 days of this quarter by green salads, vegetables, red meat, fish, whole-wheat products, etc., omitting sauces & dressings, starches, sweets & all fattening fruits. This non-fat diet supplies the minerals, vitamins & bulk the body needs but not the extra calories that it doesn't need, so that it draws on its own store. If the few extra pounds are then lost, follow a non-fat diet thereafter. Brisk walks, outdoor work & games will quicken the losing pace but retain tone.

So much for ordinary reduction to keep in trim. If obese, however, stay on this regimen for as many months as necessary, starting every Full Moon phase with the first 3.5 day's liquid diet as already suggested. Rapid reducing of obese cases is extremely undesirable and even dangerous, however, because of too-radical a change in the established tempo (seeing that most cases of obesity involve Leo and thus the heart, the body's motor). It is safer to make haste slowly, so more leeway in diet is allowed, to include whole milk, eggs, potatoes, etc. during the tapering-off period of months even a year in some cases, especially if Leo is prominent in the chart. — The Way of Astrology, 1967.

Heavenly SEX

HERE is an old story that after he was executed, Sir Thomas Moore, (1478–1535), took up an afterlife in his study, with his books. As of a century ago, he was alleged to still be there. And that's heaven, of a sort. But whenever he pops his head out, he'll rejoin the lemmings & end up right back down here.

If you want to stay in Heaven, if you want Nirvana, you have to solve the riddle of sex.

And I don't mean abstinence. Sexual denial, sexual purity, in all its many varieties, merely forces you to puzzle it out. Lack of sex provides no answers on its own, it will NOT get you off the wheel of reincarnation, it is a **DEAD END**. I will start from the beginning & show you how it works:

A man takes a woman to his bed to revel in her nakedness, to celebrate it with his orgasm. Note carefully that he is not interested in his own nakedness, nor is he interested in orgasm *per se*, as he can get naked & masturbate any time he wants.

Women take men to bed, not to have them naked, for men are far too casual with their bodies & are incapable of displaying them properly – something which is rather important to women. Nor are women interested in sharing their own orgasm with men, since men are conceptually incapable of bringing them to that point, compounded by the fact women are inherently shy. But there's more. Women process men's orgasms as their own. They turn it into something else entirely. They then radiate it back to the man. Post coital. The interplay of male orgasm & the female processing of it goes to the very heart of polarity itself.

The results of this fusion are all around us, good and bad. On the one hand, there is the well-known fact that married couples do better, socially, economically, and in every other respect, than single people, even considering that virtually all single adults are sexually active. The bad side is that almost all marriages, at one time or another, are living hells for both partners.


Close examination of the orgasmic state will tell us why. During the entire period of coitus, the male and female have fused, not only physically, but also emotionally, and, to the extent they are capable, mentally. Which means that whatever is in her head is a mirror of what's in his. Since the male is generally the active party, if he's only in it for mindless sex, chances are the female will have a fairly good time as a result. On the other hand, if he's worried about his "performance", his orgasm will be a dud & the encounter as a whole will be unsatisfactory.

It is when a man mates with a woman because of who she is, where she's been, what she's like – not what she looks like – and sacrifices himself utterly to her, that he solves the sex puzzle. When a woman mates with a man because of his perceived power and strength, taking him – gladly – as her own, becoming him, as it were, and then radiates that back to the man, that she solves the problem on her part. When the craving for that kind of intensity overwhelms genital lust, you have transcended earthly sex.

The only remaining thing is to remember this next time you find yourself in heaven. If, once you get there, you have any doubts, call out. There are guides to help. If you forget you will drift back with the tide. If you suddenly experience raw lust for genitalia, you will find yourself rushing back.

Is there sex in Heaven? Yes. Much more than here. But it's no more about genitals than eating is about teeth. Sex is ultimately about the mind, so in heaven, it becomes a whole-body experience. Which, from time to time is experienced in vivid dreams.

Broadly speaking, in heaven women are libraries of knowledge and history, and men are agents of action. The interplay of the two is endless, the variations are limitless, the results are beyond imagination. Are these gender roles permanent? Do men stay men, do women remain women, or can they change about? I don't know. I suspect they can change sex, but there were things about the Han that Marco Polo just didn't see, or understand if he did. Like him, I am only a visitor.

Giving Purgatives, part 2

ccording to Haly the lord of the ascendant, the Moon, and dispositor of the Moon should be strong, dignified, oriental, angular, and free from the aspects of the malefics, especially in the case of the Moon, the lord of the ascendant and the ascendant itself. The Moon should apply to Venus, and be in reception with the benefics; and its dispositor if weak should be in good aspect to the benefics with reception. The Moon should not apply to, or be in aspect with, Jupiter, for that hinders the effect.

If the purgative is in liquid form Scorpio is the best sign for the ascendant or Moon; if, in powder form, Cancer; and if as a pill, Pisces. Avoid the Moon in the ascendant for it tends to cause swellings, and also take care that the Moon and lord of the ascendant are not in the fourth. See that the lord of the eighth is neither angular nor in aspect with any of the significators. - Electional Astrology, by Vivian Robson.

Hidalgo

'N its most specific and mundane manifestations, Hidalgo shows as an affinity L for or contact with Spanish, Mexican, South or Latin American cultures, languages or influences. Hidalgo also deals with Church vs. State conflicts (i.e., the abortion issue) and "revolutionary" governments, or governments based on strong religious or political ideologies.

In its psychological and behavioral manifestations, Hidalgo is exhibiting the courage of one's convictions-stating one's principles or what one stands for and finds important and essential. Where Hidalgo is challenged by aspect, the principles and convictions are "subject to" the pressures & needs of the aspecting planet so that one can seem hypocritical or have "expedient" ethics, morals or principles. A person addresses your Hidalgo when they say, "Gimmie a straight answer." The configuration of Hidalgo in the chart shows how you respond, why you respond (or why you don't comply with their request). The aspects indicate hesitations, conflicts and modifications that occur as you try to state your case; the Sign of Hidalgo also shows some modifications and filtering of information. You Come right out with what's on your mind through the Sign, and in the manner of the Sign. Thus it will be noted that Hidalgo in Scorpio will "state principles (or monitor/frame disclosures) and work to exhibit convictions" in a very different way than Hidalgo in Sagittarius!
